

Sally Cowl

Materials

Any yarn and any hook! One stitch marker is needed.

I used

Universal Yarn Wool Pop in Winter Blue. It is a lightweight 3 yarn. I used a 4.0 mm Ophire Co. crochet hook. One Clover stitch marker.

Notes

The cowl is made in any multiple of 10. You can have a loose cowl or a closer fitting cowl by chaining less or more.

I chained 80 for my cowl. This is a mid-size cowl that is not too loose and not too fitting for me.

Working in rounds using a stitch marker to let us know where our next round begins.

Gauge is not crucial to this project.

Basic Stitches Used

Double Crochet

Single Crochet

Slip Stitch

Chain

Special Stitches

Two Double Crochet Cluster: Yarn over hook, go into space or stitch, yarn over and pull up, yarn over and go through two loops on hook. Yarn over and go back into the space or stitch, yarn over and pull up. Yarn over and pull through two loops on hook. Yarn over and pull through all three loops left.

Definitions

Cluster Set: A cluster set is a two double crochet cluster stitch, then a chain two, another two double crochet cluster stitch, then a chain two, followed by another two double crochet cluster stitch.

Round One

After chaining your multiple of 10, join in the round with your first chain. Make sure not to twist your work.

Single crochet in the next stitch. Place marker in that stitch.

Chain one, skip on chain.

Single crochet in the next chain.

Chain three, skip two chains.

Double crochet in the next chain.

Chain one, skip one chain.

Double crochet in the next.

Chain three, skip two chains.

Single crochet in the next chain. Chain one, skip one chain.

Single crochet in the next chain.

Repeat this all the way around the round.

At the end of the round, you will end by skipping two chains and slip stitching to the beginning single crochet stitch that has the marker in it.

Round Two

Pull up on the beginning loop on hook a bit and then do a two double crochet cluster stitch in the next chain one space. (see special stitches)

Chain two

Two double crochet cluster in same chain one space.

Chain two

Two double crochet cluster in same chain one space.

Place marker on the beginning cluster stitch to mark the beginning of the round.

Chain three.

*Single crochet in the next chain one space.

Chain three.

Cluster Set in the next chain one space. (see definitions) Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain one space.

Chain three. *

Repeat all the way around. * to * until the end of round.

At the end of the round slip stitch into your marked first cluster stitch.

Round Three

Slip stitch into the next chain 2 space.

Chain four, this counts as a double crochet and chain one.

Place marker on the third chain of chain four.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain three space. Chain one.

Single crochet in the next chain three space.

Chain three.

*Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain one.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain three space. Chain one.

Single crochet in the next chain three space.

Chain three. *

Repeat from * to * until the end of the round. Slip stitch into your third chain that has the stitch marker in it.

Round Four

Single crochet in the next chain one space. Place maker on that single crochet.

Chain three.

Cluster set in the next chain one space.

*Single crochet in the next chain one space.

Chain three. *

Repeat this all the way around to end. At the end of the round, you will slip stitch into your single crochet that is marked.

Pull up on that loop on your hook and make sure it is loose enough to work into. About an inch long loop.

Single crochet in the the next chain three space. Place maker on that chain one you just make before the single crochet.

Chain three.

Double crochet in the next chain two space. Chain one.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Single crochet in the next chain three space. Chain one.

Single crochet in the next chain three space.

Chain three.

Double crochet in the next chain two space. Chain one.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain three.

Repeat from * to * until the end of the round. At the end of this round, you will put a single crochet in the last chain three spaces.

You are now at your marker in the chain one space.

Round Six

Remove marker and make a cluster set in the chain one space that your marker was just in.

Place maker at the first cluster stitch of set, this marks the beginning of this round.

Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain one space.

Chain three.

Cluster set in the next chain one space.

*Single crochet in the next chain one space.

Repeat from * to * around until the end. Slip stitch to the beginning cluster stitch where your maker is located.

Round Seven – Repeat Round Three

Slip stitch into the next chain 2 space.

Chain four, this counts as a double crochet and chain one.

Place marker on the third chain of chain four.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain three space. Chain one.

*Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain one.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain three space. Chain one.

Single crochet in the next chain three space.

Chain three. *

Repeat from * to * until the end of the round. Slip stitch into your third chain that has the stitch marker in it.

Round Eight – Repeat Round Four

Single crochet in the next chain one space. Place maker on that single crochet.

Chain three.

Cluster set in the next chain one space.

Chain three.

*Single crochet in the next chain one space.

Repeat this all the way around to end. At the end of the round, you will slip stitch into your single crochet that is marked.

Round Nine – Repeat Round Five

Single crochet in the the next chain three space. Place maker on that chain one you just make before the single crochet.

Chain three.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain one.

Single crochet in the next chain three space.

Chain three.

Double crochet in the next chain two space. Chain one.

Repeat from * to * until the end of the round. At the end of this round you will put a single crochet in the last chain three space.

You are now at your marker in the chain one space.

Round Ten – Repeat Round Six

Remove marker and make a cluster set in the chain one space that your marker was just in.

Place maker at the first cluster stitch of set, this marks the beginning of this round.

Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain one space.

Chain three.

Cluster set in the next chain one space.

Repeat from * to * around until the end. Slip stitch to the beginning cluster stitch where your maker is located.

Continuing pattern you would repeat rounds three through six for pattern. You can end on any round you'd like.

Pattern Repeat Section Round Three

Slip stitch into the next chain 2 space.

Chain four, this counts as a double crochet and chain one.

Place marker on the third chain of chain four.

Double crochet in the next chain two space.

Chain three.

Single crochet in the next chain three space. Chain one.
