

## Men's Reversible Prayer Shawl by Spiffyniftyriffic



Size is approximately 16x86 but you can make it any Length you desire by adding or subtracting stitches on your foundation chain. To add width you can just add more rows or add more border.

Materials needed are a size M/N crochet hook (9.00mm)

And whatever kind of worsted weight yarn you enjoy working with. I used I Love This Yarn made by Hobby Lobby. I used one skein of Navy and two skeins of Gray Mist.

Yarn Needle

Gauge isn't important in this project.

This project is completely reversible so there is no wrong or right side to your work.

Start with a chain of 178 with the Gray Mist.

Row 1: Double crochet in the 3rd chain from hook and across, ch 3, turn.

Row 2: DC in every stitch across, ch 3, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have your shawl as wide as you would like it, changing colors whenever you'd like. My pattern rows were as follows: 3 Rows of Gray Mist, 1 Row of Navy, 2 Rows of Gray Mist, 1 Row of Navy, 3 Rows of Gray Mist, 3 Rows of Navy, 3 Rows of Gray Mist, 1 Row of Navy, 2 Rows of Gray Mist, 1 Row of Navy, 3 Rows of Gray Mist.

Border: With Navy, join sl st anywhere on edge of shawl, and sc in every stitch around the shawl, making sure you double sc in the corner stitches. After you have went around once, sc in each sc stitch around the shawl again, making sure this time you do 3 sc in each corner. Join with sl st where you begun, and fasten off. Weave in all of your ends from changing colors with a yarn needle.
