

Franny Poncho

Materials and Information:

The Franny Pancho was made with Premier yarns butterfly. This is a lightweight 3 yarn. I used a 4 mm hook or a G. You can use any yarn and any hook you desire. Your yarn and your hook will change the size of your poncho. Be aware that if you deviate from anything that I do on my pattern, you may make it a larger or smaller size poncho. Your tension will also make your poncho larger or smaller than my end result. Gauge is not crucial for this pattern; however, the neckline is the most important part to fit properly. If you are ending up with two large of a chain, and you do not want to change your yarn, go down a hook size or two. After round one, you can always increase your hook size and go from there. You just want to make sure that the chain and round one are large enough to go over the head of the person that will be wearing it. The stitch pattern works up in multiples of eight, however, once that is achieved you still must have four increases. The only two numbers I had work were 64, and 96. If you want to use 64 for your chain number, please refer to the video tutorial if you need help. The repeats and increases will be different than this written pattern. If you do not choose 64 or 96, you will have to figure out your increases. The poncho in the picture has one cake of butterfly yarn. The mannequin has a 34" bust at the largest part. If you need a larger size made another cake will be required. This poncho is size inclusive, and the more you continue working in the Poncho the larger it will get.

Stitches and abbreviations used: Slip stitch(SL ST), space(SP), chain(CH), single crochet(SC), double crochet(DC), V stitch(VST). V stitch definition is double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the same space. At the beginning of the round a v stitch is a chain four and a double crochet in the same space.

Pattern:

Chain 96. Join in the round (without twisting your chain) by slip stitching to your first chain.

Round one

Chain one, single crochet in the same stitch as your chain one. Single crochet in each chain across. Slip stitch to your beginning single crochet. 96 single crochets.

Round Two

Chain four, double crochet in the same space as the chain four.

Chain one, Skip two stitches. In the next three stitches, place one double crochet in each.

Chain one, skip two stitches. Double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the next stitch.

Chain one, skip two stitches. In the next three stitches, put a double crochet in each.

Chain one, skip two stitches. Double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the next stitch.

Chain one, skip two stitches. In the next three stitches, put a double crochet in each.

Repeat this all the way around.

End the round with the three double crochets, chain one and skipping two. Slip stitch to the third chain of your chain four.

Round Three - Increase Round using stitch markers

Slip stitch over to your first chain one space.

Chain four, and put a double crochet in the same space. Chain one, and put another double crochet in the space. Chain one again, and put another double crochet in that same space. Place your marker in the middle V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet in the chain one of your V stitch. Chain one, and put another double crochet in the chain one space.

Chain one again, and put another double crochet in that same space. Chain one, and put another double crochet in the same stitch or space. Place your marker in the middle V stitch.

Now we are going to keep repeating that.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet in the chain one of your V stitch. Chain one, and put another double crochet in the chain one space. Chain one again, and put another double crochet in that same space. Chain one, and one more double crochet in the same space. Place your marker in the middle V stitch.

Continue repeating the pattern as you have to the end of the round. At the end of the round:

Chain one, slip stitch into the third chain of your chain four.

Round Four - no increase round

Work stitches in your stitches without increasing.

Slip stitch to your chain one space.

Chain four, put a double crochet in the same space as your chain four.

Go to your next V stitch (marked) and put a V stitch in it. Move maker to the new v stitch.

In the next v stitch, put a v stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one. In the next 3 V stitches place a V stitch in each and put the stitch marker in the middle V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

We are going to keep repeating this all the way around.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

In the next 3 V stitches place a V stitch in each and put the stitch marker in the middle V stitch.

Round five - increase round

Increase only in the stitches where the stitch markers are located. All other stitches are worked into just like previous rounds. Slip stitch to your first chain one space.

Chain four and double crochet in the same space as your chain four.

In the marked stitch, double crochet, chain one, double crochet-chain one, double crochet-chain one, double crochet. Place your marker in the middle V.

Place a V stitch in the next V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, double crochet, chain one, double crochet in the V stitch.

Chain one, in the next three double crochets, place a double crochet in each.

Chain one, In the next V stitch place a V stitch.

In the marked stitch, double crochet, chain one, double crochet-chain one, double crochet -chain one, double crochet. Place your marker in the middle V stitch.

Chain one, slip stitch to the third chain of your beginning chain four.

You will now repeat rounds four and five. Round four we do not increase, round five we do increase. All odd rounds we increase, all even we do not increase.

Even rounds we work in all our stitches just as they are. Odd rounds we increase only at the stitch markers.

Keep doing those two rounds until you reach the size you desire for your poncho. The picture shows one cake of butterfly.

I did not place an edging on this poncho. I thought it would detract from the patterning in the poncho. You can add any edging you would like to because it is your project!

Repeat Rounds for Pattern Abbreviated

Round Four - no increase round

Work stitches in your stitches without increasing.

SL ST to your CH1 SP.

CH4, put a DC in the same SP as your CH4.

Put a V ST in all V STS, put marker back in middle V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

CH1.

Put a V ST in all V STS, put marker back in middle V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

CH1.

Put a V ST in all V STS, put marker back in middle V ST.

Repeat this patterning all the way around, at the end of round:

CH1. SL ST to the third chain of your beginning CH4.

Round five - increase round

Increase only in the stitches where the stitch markers are located. All other stitches are worked into just like previous rounds. Slip stitch to your first chain one space.

CH4, put a DC in the same SP as your CH4.

Place V ST in all V STS except the marked V ST we increase.

In the marked stitch, DC, CH1, DC---CH1,DC---CH1, DC. Place your marker in the middle V. Place V ST in all V STS.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

CH1. Place V ST in all V STS except the marked V ST we increase.

In the marked stitch, DC, CH1, DC---CH1,DC---CH1, DC. Place your marker in the middle V. Place V ST in all V STS.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

V ST in the V ST.

CH1, in the next three DC, place a DC in each.

CH1. Place V ST in all V STS except the marked V ST we increase.

In the marked stitch, DC, CH1, DC---CH1,DC---CH1, DC. Place your marker in the middle V. Place V ST in all V STS.

Repeat this patterning all the way around until the end. At the end:

CH1. SL ST to the third chain of your beginning CH4.
